	Ray provided an oral report for the year's achievements. Key point being:	
	<ul> <li>Player numbers increased to 997 in season 2023, a 17% increase on last year.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Female membership has increased again, now 25% of players.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Council committing significant investment in refurbishing High St and DLRW, great news in the long term, however will bring a challenge in season 2024 as works are finalized.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Longer term planning is for significant Warner reserve upgrade in 2026.</li> </ul>

	Senior Men's and Women's both recorded their highest finishes in 2023 and are well placed	
	to push for promotion in 2024.	
	<ul> <li>Junior NPL had our strongest results to date with three teams making finals</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Next year will be the clubs 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary.</li> </ul>	
5	Treasurers Report	
	Ben provided a verbal report of the Club's performance for 2023 Season and referred to the Treasurers Report made available for review prior to the Annual General Meeting. Key points being:	
	<ul> <li>Revenue increased to \$741k (up from 593k)</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Operating loss of \$79.9k, primarily due to poor weather leading to significant external</li> </ul>	
	ground hire. Flow on effect in reduced canteen revenue. Uniform costs were also \$21k over budget.	
	The Chair opened the meeting for any questions on the Financial Statements and Auditors Report.	
	- The Audited Financial Statements are for the period 1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023	
	• The Chair then proposed that the Financial Statement for the year ended 30 September 2023	
	together with the Independent Auditors' report, be accepted.	
	• The Financial Statement for the year ended 30 September 2023 together with the Independent	
	Auditors' report were unanimously accepted by members. <ul> <li>Proposed – Ray Verratti</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Seconded – Zeno Hamzi</li> </ul>

	1. Paul Crisp queried whether we had sought any compensation from council regarding reimbursement of external ground hire. Ray advised the club has made a formal submission to council.	
	2. Kayt queried whether all grants were included in the financial reports. Ben advised yes all were included.	
	3. Tim queried the grounds situation and potential impact on season 2024. Ray advised that this was acknowledged as a very difficult situation and teams would be impacted, and the committee is working through how best to manage the limited resources. Impacted teams will be notified before 31-Dec-2023.
